Dear Special Agent Heller,

I am writing to you regarding the above cited cases. I was recently introduced to Mr. David Haeg and had the opportunity to learn about his cases by discussing them with him and reviewing the attendant court documents. It became clear to me, as it has with many others who have become acquainted with these court cases, that there is a huge miscarriage of justice occurring in these proceedings. The magnitude and multitude of lies, deception, corruption and complicity is stunning. I implore you to initiate an investigation of the corruption which has been rife in these above cited cases; corruption on several levels.

I worked with a court case as a paralegal when I first moved to Alaska in 1991 which also was rife with corruption involving attorneys, borough officials, state employees and the lower court judge. It was a harsh introduction to "how things are done" in Alaska. Having worked for several years in the legal / court systems in IN and MI, I was apparently naive about and overwhelmed by the massive scale in which corruption operates in Alaska. It is clear that the corruption which fosters ongoing miscarriages of justice does not resolve itself when left unaddressed; but instead proliferates. I am sure that as a FBI Special Agent you are thoroughly familiar with that truth. It seems apparent that a so-called justice system that is as broken and void of any integrity as that which resides in the State of Alaska serves no purpose except to enrich the bank accounts of the players of the "justice facade". As a mother and grandmother, I must tell you that is not what I want for my children and grandchildren. It is not acceptable for yours either. I am willing to assist you in any way I am able to address this intolerable situation of injustice and corruption within this beautiful State of Alaska. This is a problem too big to go unaddressed and a justice system too necessary to fail.

To quote an unknown author: " There is no calamity which a great nation can invite which equals that which follows a supine submission to wrong and injustice and the consequent loss of national self respect and honor. beneath which are shielded and defended a people's safety and greatness. "
